Dear Parents/Caregivers of Year 11 Research Project Students,

By now, your child has completed the Folio (30%) and is working towards completing their Outcome (40%) for Research Project. We are writing to remind you about the school's expectations and requirements for the completion of the Research Project, a compulsory Stage 2 component of the South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE).

The Research Project is a vital part of the curriculum and must be completed by the end of the semester to a C- grade or better. This standard ensures that students are adequately prepared for the rigors of Year 12 and are on track to successfully complete their SACE.

We emphasize that it is crucial for students to meet this requirement. Students who do not achieve a C- grade or better in the Research Project will be required to enrol in an alternative educational institution, such as Marden or Thebarton Senior Colleges, to redo the subject. This enrolment will be at the student's and family's own expense and time. Furthermore, the Research Project must be successfully completed by the end of 2024 to ensure students can be promoted to Year 12.

Our teachers and support staff are committed to providing all necessary resources, guidance, and assistance to help students achieve success in their Research Project. We encourage you to support your child throughout this process by monitoring their progress and ensuring they access additional supports as necessary, including Academic Support on Tuesdays and Thursdays.
