Please see below for some reminders.

Students will be performing their item to staff on Monday 29 July at 2:20pm in the CCAT. They will be dismissed outside the main reception at 2:50pm.

We will depart school at 2:30pm via private bus (Adelaide Transport). We need to arrive at the theatre by 3:00pm. Students will be involved in a full-dress/tech rehearsal at the theatre from 4:15-4:45pm.

During the break, students will be provided with a pizza dinner.

The performance will run from 7:15-9:00pm. Students will remain with staff until after the performance, where they must be collected by their legal carer/guardian. If someone other than yourself will be collecting your child, please provide full information in writing.

On Wednesday 7 August, students must come to school in their full school uniform. We will rehearse during lessons 3 and 4. They will be given time to change into their costumes before heading to the theatre.

Students will need to bring the following:
