This will take place on **Friday 21 June 2024 (Week 8)**.

The students have already selected their recipes and have begun writing them into Italian. They are eagerly looking forward to making and bringing their chosen food to school to share with their peers. Here's how you can support them in making this event a success:

- Each student has a budget of \$20 for this project. Please help them stick to this budget and avoid spending too much. This will be a great lesson in managing resources and planning a meal within constraints. Please advise us if this may not be achievable under any circumstance.
- The students are expected to take the lead in the cooking process, with your guidance and supervision. Please allow them to do as much of the preparation and cooking as safely possible.
- Since our lesson will run through until 11:50am, it is important to keep the food cool and fresh until then. We recommend using insulated containers or cool bags to ensure the dishes remain at an appropriate temperature. Please advise us if this may not be possible for you.
- Please make sure to label any containers with your name or child's name.



Each student will be given an electronic copy of an Italian Recipe book with all their peers' recipes. Thank you for your on-going support and engagement in your child's learning.
